Dependent Resurvey, Township Line, Tps. 4 and 5 S., R. 11 W.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 25 ins. in the sand, firmly set in a mixture of concrete and rocks, 2½ ft. diam., at the surface, 2 ft. deep, with brass cap mkd.

A wood post, 8 ft. long, 6 ins. diam., firmly set 3 ft. in the sand, bears East, 4 lks. dist.

Continue over rolling sandspit.

14.20 Point for the witness cor. to the meander cor. of sec. 1 only, falls at E. base of low sand ridge on W. side of North Spit.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the sand, firmly set in a mixture of concrete and rocks, 2½ ft. diam., at the surface, 2 ft. deep, with brass cap mkd.

16.60 True point for the meander cor. of sec. 1 only, falls on unstable sand at high water line of the Pacific Ocean, where it is impracticable to establish a permanent monument.

17.65 Find no evidence of the witness meander cor. of sec. 36 only, established by Lincoln E. Wilkes in 1924.

Land, rolling sandspit.
Soil, sand.
Vegetation, beach grass.

Meanders of North Spit, Sec. 1, T. 5 S., R. 11 W.

From the true point for the meander cor. of sec. 1 only, on the W. side of North Spit.

Thence with the meanders of the shoreline of the Pacific Ocean.

S. 5° 05' W., 24.25 chs. along sandy beach.

S. 2° 13' W., 26.50 chs.

S. 4° 31' E., 8.50 chs.

S. 27° 40' E., 8.00 chs. Most southerly point of North Spit, leaving Pacific Ocean shoreline and continue along NW. shore of Nestucca Bay.

N. 75° 41' E., 3.30 chs.

N. 4° 59' E., 2.30 chs.

N. 22° 38' W., 5.00 chs.
