RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 15 and 16,
Township 3 South, Range 7 West, W. M., Tillamook
County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

14" x 12" x 7" stone (in place marked 1/4 on W. face.)

RESTORATION by Frank H. Sharp, 1894, retracement of the Section
line between 15 and 16.

Original Stone from which a:

6" fir bears N 7 1/2 E 84 lks.; missing.

7" fir bears S 82 3/4 W 55 lks.; missing.

RESTORED

Var 21 1/2 E

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON
STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S 15 S16 1966 R.S. 707",
31 inches in ground, with badly broken corner stone on North
side, in mound of rock and from which a:

22" fir bears N 77 3/4 E 11.6 ft.; scribed 1/4 S15 BT RS 707.

19" fir bears N 88 W 30.5 ft.; scribed 1/4 S16 BT.

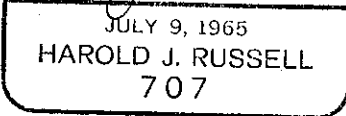
Set 4" x 4" x 50" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe.
