18.50	Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 115 ft. over N. slope, changing to NW. slope.								
21.75	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.								
39.70	The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20, monumented with the original basalt stone, 15 x 12 x 8 ins., firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, mkd. with 5 notches on E. edge.								
	At the corner point								
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	N. 89° 30' W., bet. secs. 17 and 20.								
	Descend 5 ft. along rocky N. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.								
2.20	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 30° E., enter partially logged area, edge bears SE. and W.; asc. 200 ft. over steep NE. slope.								
10.00	Spur, slopes N. 10° E.; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.								
13.20	Ravine, drains N. 15° W.; asc. 70 ft. over NE. slope.								
20.30	Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.								
22.50	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 65° E.; asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.
