

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 4 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 39° W., 18½ lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S19 BT.

Deposit the original stone alongside the iron post.

N. 89° 47' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 30 ft. along broken N. slope, changing to NE. slope.

22.00 Spur, slopes N. 65° W.; desc. 320 ft. over SW. slope.

37.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.

39.50 The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which the remaining 1933 bearing trees:

A rotted fir stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 81° E., 37 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 50° E., 9 lks. dist., mkd. with a healed blaze. (Record, 6 lks.)

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears N. 44½° W., 54 lks. dist., mkd. with a healed blaze.

add new bearing trees:

An alder, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 42° E., 56½ lks. dist., bark scribed T4S R7W S18 BT.

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 46½ lks. dist., mkd. T4S R8W S24 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, alder, cascara, maple, spruce and hemlock; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, devil's club, huckleberry, salmonberry, Oregon grape, fern, elderberry, and willow.

From the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20.

N. 0° 20' W., bet. secs. 17 and 18.

Descend 210 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

7.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 60° W.; asc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.

9.00 Top of ascent, slopes N. 80° W.; desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope.
