

Dependent Resurvey of Base Line, Portion of S. Bdy. of T. 1 N., R. 9 W.

Chains	
68.30	Ravine, drains N.; ascend 93 ft. along steep N. slope.
70.93	Point for the closing corner of Sections 1 and 2, on the N. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W., hereinafter described. Ascend 33 ft. along steep N. slope.
74.53	Point for the corner of Sections 35 and 36 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mhd. <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T 1 N R 9 W S 35 S 36 S 2 T 1 S R 9 W 1959</p> </div> from which An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 63° E., 116 lks. dist., bark scribed TIN RSW S36 BT. A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 20° W., 42 lks. dist., mhd. TIN RSW S35 BT. Lead, mountainous headwaters of White Creek. Soil, rocky clay with numerous large rock outcroppings. Timber, hemlock, fir alder, cedar, and spruce, deadened by fire except along the creeks and low spurs; undergrowth, salmonberry, vine maple, devil's-club, huckleberry, sword fern, young alder, and reproduction.
	S. 87° 17' W., along the S. bdy. of Section 35. Descend 45 ft. over NW. slope, through dense reproduction.
0.87	Wet ravine, drains N. 10° E.; ascend 500 ft. over steep E. slope, changing to NE. slope.
11.50	Main ridge dividing Wilson River and Kilchis River drainage, bears N. 20° E. and S.; descend 146 ft. over NW. slope.
15.21	Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of Section 2 only, on the N. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mhd. <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>E 1/16 S 2 1959</p> </div> from which A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 69° E., 14 lks. dist., marked X BT. An alder, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 96 lks. dist., bark scribed E 1/16 S2 BT. Descend 350 ft. over NW. slope, changing to steep W. slope.
24.00	Leave reproduction, edge bears N. and S.; enter live old growth timber.
