The east bdy. of T4²R9W was established by H. Meldrum in 1879. Then retraced in 1879 by Charles E. Branson who said that he found the old T.P. corner at a dist. along the east bdy. of T6, 30 north of the corner of secs. 6 & 7, however it is not clear to me whether he actually found the orig. 1879 cor. or the reestablishment determined by Samuel D. Caudle in 1880.

In 1834 H. Meldrum makes no mention of his corner (T.P.) which he established in 1879, but rather he describes the T.P. cor. estab. by S. D. Caudle in 1880, and surveys 6 miles east from same.

H. Meldrum surveyed the north bdy. at the same time he surveyed the east bdy. (1879)
