RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One Quarter corner common to Sections 27 and 34, T3S, R7W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon

ORIGINAL

Stone 13" x 9" x 6" (Found in place 6" in ground $\frac{1}{4}$ on North side).

RESTORED

Var 21 $\frac{1}{2}$

Marked X in top of original stone, from which a:

- 16" Fir bears S61E 2.7 ft. to face; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 BT RS 707.
- 19" Fir bears N37W 3.2 ft. to face; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 50" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner stone.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 19" fir BT.
Also poster on 24" fir S55 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 146.0' on northerly edge of logging road
(S60W by N70E).
