CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY.

Section corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, T4S, R7W, W.M., Tillamook and Yamhill Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

No evidence of original corner found.

REESTABLISHED by U. S. Cadastral Resurvey, 1965.

Iron post 28" long, 2½" diam, with brass cap (now missing) from which a:

26" Fir bears N74°E 119 lks.; missing.

29" Fir bears S52°E 80.5 lks.; scribes visible on partially grown over face.

37" Fir bears S37°W 59 lks.; scribes visible on partially grown over face.

14" Alder bears N38°W 28 lks.; scribes visible.

RESTORED

Var 21½ E

Set 15" x 23" x 14" stone, marked X in top, in Bible Creek course N55W, and in mound of rock.

Did not mark any new bearing trees.
