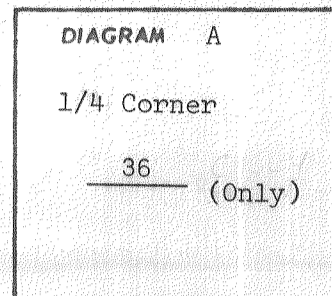


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally set in 1872, 40 chains West of  $\frac{36}{6} \frac{31}{6}$ . A post was set from which a:

- 30" Hemlock N 35° E 35 lks.
- 10" Hemlock S 32° E 25 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a 1/2" iron pipe, and the SE BT. The BT has been up-rooted. Scribed marks are visible but illegible. I found three recently marked BT's.

- 6" Hemlock S 87° W 3.1 ft.
- 10" mkd "LS 784"
- 10" Hemlock N 34° W 25.9 ft.
- mkd "T 5 S R 11 W 1/4 S 36 BT"
- 10" Hemlock N 24° E 33.8 ft.
- mkd "T 5 S R 11 W 1/4 S 36 BT"

All above mentioned BT's appear to have been marked by LS No. 784.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a 2 1/2" X 30" Galvanized iron pipe with a flared bottom and brasscap riveted to the top marked:

T 5 S R 11 W

1/4 | S 36

1973

RLS 942

The above mentioned BT's are standing and vigorous. I marked no additional trees.
