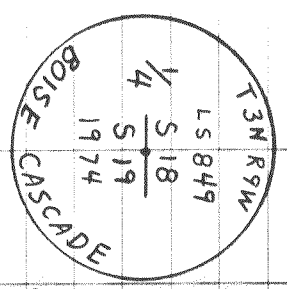

A 14" HEMLOCK BEARS S 30°W 16.3 FT. TO FACE SCRIBED " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 BT"

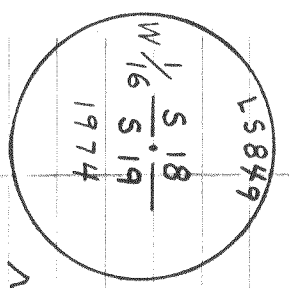
A 8" HEMLOCK BEARS N 63°E 20.7 FT. TO FACE SCRIBED " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 BT"
