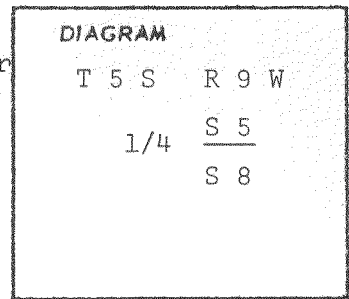


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally set by the G.L.O. in 1880 under contract No. 364. They set a post from which:

- 5" Willow S 22° W 30 lks.
- 40" Fir N 60° W 122 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

I found no evidence of the original corner or its accessories.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At proportionate measurement, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a brasscap riveted to the top marked:

T 5 S    R 9 W

1/4    S 5

          S 8

1975

RPLS 942

from which:

- 24" Fir S 14° E 14.0 feet  
mkd. "1/4 S 8 BT"
- 21" Fir N 16° W 19.1 feet  
mkd. "1/4 S 5 BT"

All bearing trees have been banded with red paint and attention signs and BT tags have been attached. All scribes have a 3/4" brass washer, with "LS 942" engraved on it, nailed in the face.

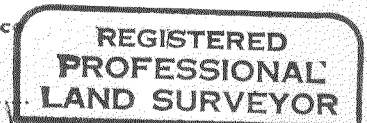
