CHAINS

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, T2N, R7W, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Basalt stone 20" x 12" x 12", (found on North side 1½" iron pipe in  
place--see below) from which a:

- 12" Hemlock bears N50°E 57 lks.; missing.
- 24" Hemlock bears S42°E 70 lks.; missing.
- 30" Hemlock bears S41°W 42 lks.; now 30" stump with rotten face,  
scribes rotted and burnt away.
- 20" Hemlock bears N68°W 51 lks.; now 32" stump with scribes visible.

RESTORATION by L. W. Amort, August 15, 1952.

OSBF 1½" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap 28" in ground (in place)  
from which a:

- 18" Fir snag bears S64°W 95.1 ft.; now an 18" stump with scribes visible.
- 30" Fir stump bears N32°W 61.3 ft.; now 30" stump with scribes T2N R7W  
S BT visible.
- 21" Fir stump bears N65°E 92.7 ft.; now 21" stump with scribes T2N R7W  
S1 BT visible.
- 36" Fir tree bears S69°E 208.6 ft.; now a 36" snag with scribes visible.

REWITNESSED

Var. 21½°E

From above corner monument in mound of rock, a:

- 9" Noble fir bears S27°E 23.2 ft. to face; scribed T2N R7W S12 BT RS 707.
- 10" Noble fir bears S9-3/4°W 43.6 ft. to face; scribed T2N R7W S11 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe.  
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 16" Noble fir  
stump S88°W 3.7 feet.
