Basalt Stone 16" x 10" x 8" (now missing) from which as

- 5" Maple bears N58W 31 lbs.; missing.
- 3" Hemlock bears N37E 44 lbs.; missing.
- 30" Hemlock bears S42E 32 lbs.; now 30" stub 8' high, face and scribes rotted away.
- 8" Hemlock bears S34W 27 lbs.; missing.

Original line blazes to the North and East.
 Swine bears West 1 chain, now in place using slope distance.
 Ridge bears East 7 chains, now in place using slope distance.
 Ridge bears South 5.50 chains; now in place using slope distance.

- 22" Hemlock bears S33W 118.9 ft.; scribed T15 R2W S7 S8 RM401.
- 30" Hemlock bears N77W 120.1 ft.; scribed T15 R2W S6 S7.
- Base of rock outcrop bears S33E 47.3 ft.; X BC.
