

County Surveyor's Record, Tillamook County, Oregon

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Corner to Sections 34 and 35--reestablished from Douglass's closing corner to Sections 2 and 3 and set on the Township Line.

S 1/4 Corner to Section 35--reestablished from Meldrum's original 1/4 corner to Sections 35 and 2, placed on the Township Line.

N 1/4 Corner to Section 2--midpoint distance from Douglass's closing corner to Sections 1 and 2 and Sections 2 and 3, placed on the Township Line. (No monument set)

N 1/4 Corner to Section 1--midpoint distance between the original corner to T3 and 4S, Range 9 and 9W, as established by Henry Meldrum, and the closing corner to Sections 1 and 2 as noted by William Douglass, placed on the Township Line. This is probably not the original closing corner as established by Branson. The Alder bearing trees found by Mervin Whitmore have different bearings and distances than the original record. Douglass also finds the tie to the section corner 0.31 chains short of Branson. It could be this corner was established by Sappington. As Douglass used this corner in his survey and no evidence could be found of Branson's corner, I am accepting it as the closing corner.

E 1/16 Corner on the North Line of Section 1--1/4 distance from the Township corner as established by Henry Meldrum and the closing corner to Sections 1 and 2 as established by William Douglass.
