CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Closing Township corner common to Sections 31 and 6 (West end), T2 & 3S, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing) from which a:

- 24" Hemlock bears N45°E 24 lks.; missing.
- 18" Hemlock bears N61½°W 45 lks.; missing.
- 26" Hemlock bears S25½°E 40 lks.; now 25" windfall snag, scribes BT remaining on badly burned and rotted face.

RESTORED

Var. 21½° E.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S S36 R8W/T2S R7W S31/S6 CC T3S 1975 RS707", 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 14" Fir bears S06°E 156.7 ft. to face; scribed T3S R7W S6 CC BT.
- 12" Fir bears N17½°E 183.3 ft. to face; scribed T2S R7W S31 CC BT RS707.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 10" Fir S52¼°W 8.3 ft.
