Retracement of section line between Sections 9 - 10, by M. Whitmore,
8/3/58, north.

- 466 feet Original blazes on N-S sides of old snag.
- 870 feet Original blaze on snag.
- 1350 feet Original blaze on snag.
- 1670 feet Top of high ridge NE-SW. (Original record is 1650 feet NE-SW). Many old blazes are found on line as we continue north.
- 5020 feet A point on line from which is a 60-inch snag, S. 78° E., 80 links. As no other snags can be found on line, several hundred feet to the north and south, I believe this snag is the original S.E. witness. Therefore, I re-witness this corner.

- 51.60 Brook, 4 lks. wide, runs SW.; asc. hill from brook, bears NW. and SE.
