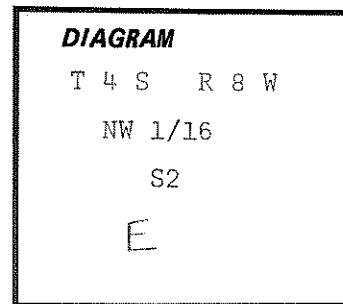


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

At proportionate measurement I set a 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized iron pipe with a flared bottom and a brasscap riveted to the top marked:

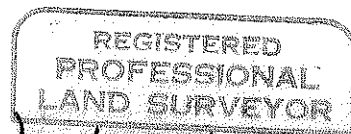
