CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 3, 4, 33, and 34, T3&4N, R7W, W.M., Tillamook and Clatsop Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, November 19, 1891.

Post; missing from which a:

- 5" Hemlock bears N46⁰E 11 lks.; missing.
- 6" Hemlock bears S42⁰E 25 lks.; now 9" windfall, badly rotted, axe work visible.
- 36" Hemlock bears S24⁰W 16 lks.; now 30" stub, 6' high, badly rotted, portions of scribes 3NR7W visible.
- 30" Hemlock bears N40⁰W 57 lks.; now 36" stump, badly rotted, scribes BT visible.

RESTORATION by unknown.

Squared post; found out of place.

Set 1½" X 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked 'OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T4N R7W S33 S34 S4 S3 T3N 1984 RS 1998", 34 inches in ground, in remains of rotten Fir log, and from which a:

- 9" Fir bears N39⁰W 17.6 ft. to face; scribed T4NR7WS33BT.
- 7" Hemlock bears S35⁰W 10.5 ft. to face; scribed T3NR7WS4BT.
- 12" Hemlock bears S49⁰E 33.7 ft. to face; scribed T3NR7WS3BT.
- 7" Hemlock bears N69⁰E 19.1 ft. to face; scribed T4NR7WS34BT.

Set 4"X4"X60" white painted Cedar post N56⁰E 1.2 ft. from corner pipe.

Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on original 36" Hemlock Bt and new BTs.

Northern Pacific Railway poster on 19" Noble Fir N51⁰W 31.6 ft.
