## CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 33, T3N & 4N, R7W, W.M., Clatsop and Tillamook Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, November 19, 1891.

Post missing, from which a:

7" Hemlock bears  $N42^{\circ}W$  37 lks.; now missing.

5" Hemlock bears  $S8^{\circ}W$  34 lks.; now rotted remains, face has fallen off, portion of scribing visible on face.

RESTORED

Var.  $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 30''$  aluminum pipe with  $3\frac{3}{4}''$  aluminum cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T4N R7W  $\frac{1}{4}$  S33 S4 T3N 1984 RS 1998", 28 inches in ground, and from which a:

11" Hemlock bears  $S65^{\circ}E$  1.4 ft. to face; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}S4BT$ .

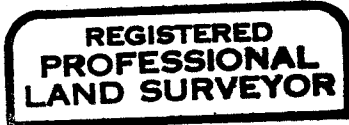
9" Fir bears  $N56^{\circ}W$  22.0 ft. to face; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}S33BT$ .

Set  $4'' \times 4'' \times 72''$  white painted Cedar post  $N66^{\circ}E$  3.9 ft. from corner pipe.

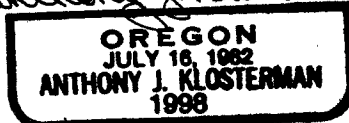
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on new BTs.
