

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 17, T2N, R7W, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, September 14, 1891.

18"X12"X5" Stone; missing, from which a:

- 20" Hemlock bears S60°E 56 lks; now a badly rotted stub,  
no scribes visible.
- 32" Hemlock bears S52°W 26 lks; now badly rotted remains of  
root crown.
- Top of ridge bears North 1.2 chains; in place.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE 2311, June 7, 1952, (Book 2  
Page 221, Tillamook Co. Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, in mound  
of stone; found in place, from which a:

- 47" Fir snag bears S46°W 43.4 ft.; now a 47" stump, no  
scribes visible.
- 40" Fir stub bears N36°E 16.4 ft.; now a 40" badly rotted  
stump, scribes RE 2311 visible.

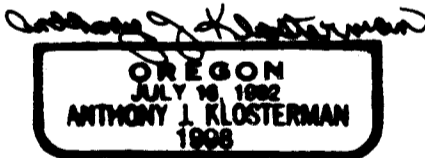
From above pipe, added marks "LS 1998 1987" and from which a:

- 9" Noble Fir bears N28°E 19.8 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S16BT.
- 12" Fir bears S62°W 8.2 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S17BT.
