

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Closing corner common to Sections 4, and 5, T1S, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL By Albert P. Wilson, November 9, 1891.

Post; missing.

- 14" Hemlock bears N70 1/2°W 9 lks.; missing.
- 50" Hemlock bears S22°W 58 lks.; now a 52" badly rotted stump, face is laying on ground with scribes T1SR7W visible.
- 12" Hemlock bears S10°E 106 lks.; now a 13" badly rotted windfall out of place, no scribes visible.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, August 15, 1952 (Book 2, page 167, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap; in place.

- 63" Fir stump bears S13 1/2°E 71.3 ft.; now 63", badly rotted, with scribes CC T1S R7W S4 BT RE2311 visible.
- 84" Fir snag bears S63°W 118.8 ft.; now a 84" stump with portions of scribes CC 1S R7 S5 BT visible.
- Yellow metal location poster on 52" Hemlock snag bears N22°E 38.3 ft.; now a 52" stump with poster missing.

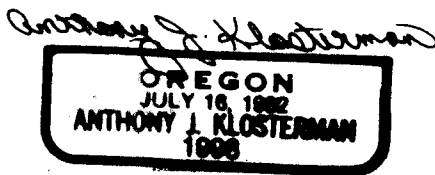
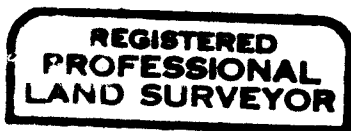
From above pipe with marks "1987 LS1998" added, and from which a:
