

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 12, T3N, R10W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by C.J. Handley, August 25, 1873.

Post; missing, from which a:

- 12" Hemlock bears N10°W 19 lks; missing.
- 14" Hemlock bears S70°E 18 lks; missing.

REESTABLISHMENT by Richard A. Morris LS401, February 7, 1963, (See
plat# B-473, Tillamook Co. Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 35" in ground;
in place, and from which a:

- 24" Hemlock bears N21°W 26.9 ft.; now a 24" badly rotted
uprooted stump, no scribes visible.
- 31" Hemlock S30 1/2°W 36.7 ft.; now a 31" badly rotted stump
with portions of scribes 1/4 S12 BT RS401 visible.
- 4"x4"x56" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. SE of pipe; in place.

REWITNESSED January 26, 1988

Var. 21 1/2°E

From above pipe with marks "1988 LS1998" added, and from which a:

- 7" Fir bears N16°E 7.0 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S1BT.
- 9" Fir bears S56°E 15.8 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S12BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
