

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Center one quarter corner for Section 8, T3S, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Arnold G. Gibson LS359, April 24, 1957 (Book 2, page 353 and Plat #A-715, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2 "x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 34" in ground; missing, and from which a:

22" Fir bears N07E 36.4 ft.; now a 21" rotted stump, face closed.

23" Fir bears S07 1/2E 19.8 ft.; now a 23" rotted stump with portions of scribes visible through partially closed face.

4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. SW; missing.

RESTORATION by Arthur E. Mosher LS502, June, 1975 (See Plat #A-2850, Tillamook County Records).

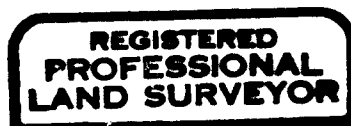
Iron rod; found a 5/8" rebar, 6" above ground, in place.

REWITNESSED February 18, 1988 Var. 21 1/2 E
Placed a yellow plastic cap marked "LS1998" on above rebar and from which a:

10" Fir bears N86 1/2E 38.4 ft. to face; scribed C1/4S8BT.
11" Fir bears N27E 33.2 ft. to face; scribed C1/4S8BT.

4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post N42W 2.9 ft. from corner pipe.
Metal location poster on new BTs.
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
