

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

North one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 11 and 12, T1N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Richard A. Morris LS401, December 31, 1959 (Book 2, page 417 and Plat #B-419, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 34" in ground; in place.

26" Hemlock bears S25W 47.9 ft.; now a 26" badly rotted stump with no scribes visible, (O.R. Miller BT).

18" Hemlock bears N32 1/2E 195.5 ft.; now an 18" badly rotted windfall with no scribes visible.

4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. SW of corner pipe; in place.

Centerline of Stewart Road bears East 24.0 ft. course N10E by S15E; in place.

From the above pipe with marks "LS1998 1989" added, and from which a:

17" Alder bears S55W 17.9 ft. to barkscribes N1/16S11BT.

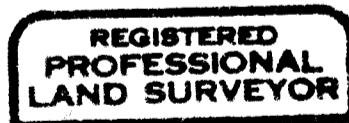
14" Hemlock bears S15E 241.1 ft. to face; scribed N1/16S12BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

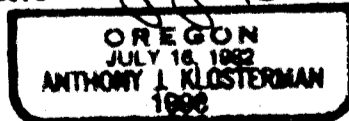
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of 14" Hemlock BT.
