

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Closing corner common to Sections 3 and 4, T1S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Frank H. Sharp, September 6, 1893.

Post; missing.

- 12" Hemlock bears S82 1/2E 100 lks.; now a 12"x 2 1/2 ft. high badly rotted stub with no scribes visible.
- 8" Hemlock bears S22 1/2W 92 lks.; now an 18" x 5 ft. badly rotted windfall with no scribes visible.
- 8" Hemlock bears N30W 47 lks.; missing.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, April 30, 1952 (Book 2, page 158, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground, in mound of stone; in place.

- 72" Fir stump bears N60W 15.2 ft.; now a 72" rotted stump with no scribes visible.
- 5" Fir bears S29 1/2W 144.0 ft.; now 26" with closed face.
- 5" Fir bears S64E 116.0 ft.; missing.

From the above pipe with marks "LS1998 1989" added, a:

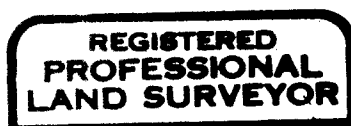
- 13" Alder bears S41E 35.2 ft. to barkscribes T1SR8WCCS3BT.
- 20" Fir bears S44W 60.0 ft. to face; scribed T1SR8WCCS4BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

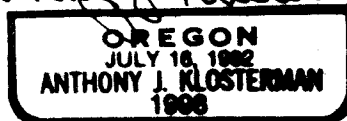
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
