In 1923 I wanted to burn the area and so the location of the corner (then a wooden post, part of which is still wired to the corner pipe) would not be lost, I drove a wagon axle along side of the post and left the axle sticking up a couple of feet. While I was working for Crown Zellerbach I put in a babbit filled bell topped pipe stamped PW with the section numbers on it alongside of the post and axle
