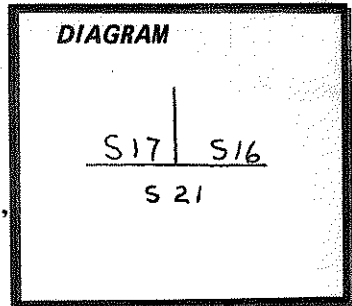


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

S. Caudle in 1880 set a stone (no marks) from which a fir 36 ins diam bears S81°W 18 lks.

Wilson in 1890 could not find Caudle's stone. He set a post 4 ins sq. 4 ft. long 24 ins. in ground, mkt T6S R10W S17 on NW, T6S R10W S16 on NE, T6S R10W S21 on SE, T6S R10W S20 on SW face, 3 notches on south, and 4 on east, from which:



A dead fir snag 50 ins diam bears N84°W 29 lks mkt T6S R10W S17 BT.
A willow 4 ins diam bears S72°E 47 lks mkt T6S R10W S21 BT.
Raised a mound of stone around corner 4 ft. at base, 2 ft. high.

M. Whitmore found original post still standing and remains of N.W. B.T.

Description of corner evidence found:

Monument found:

4" x 4" orig post, marking not visible, flat faces on 2 sides. Also find 1/4" iron rod 48" long, beside orig. post, set by L. Whitmore in 1973.
Did not find stone mound.

BT's found:

Find remains of original 50" snag, now a rotted stump, at record bearing and distance. Could find no trace of willow. Find M. Whitmore's BT's set in 1959.
DF 36" diam bears N79°E 28.0 ft. Healed face,
DF 46" diam bears N60° W 61.5 ft. (call 61.0 ft) Healed face,

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Monument set:

I replace orig post with a 3" x 30" aluminum cap with magnet in top and bottom marked:

T6S R10W
S17 | S16
S21
RLS 1050
1979

Bury orig post and iron rod alongside cap.
Put post and Attn sign 3' north of cap.

Accessories:

Painted 6" red band around both BT's. Put Attn sign on back of BT's.
