

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One-Quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 36, T3&4N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook and Clatsop Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing). from which a:

20" fir bears N60°E 20 lks.; now a 20" fir uprooted stump with scribes BT visible.
24" fir bears South 8 lks.; now a 26" fir stump S28½°E 5.28' with scribes BT visible.

RESTORATION by OSHD, 1941.

Found 2 bearing trees marked ¼S BT and a 1½" iron pin.
Replaced the pin with a 2" x 48" galvanized iron pipe with a brass cap (in place).
Set a 4" x 4" white guard post (in place).
Did not scribe BT's.

Above mentioned 2" x 48" pipe, from which a:

11" fir bears N48½°E 9.1 ft. to face; scribed 1/4 S36 BT.
12" fir bears S46¼°E 16.2 ft. to face; scribed 1/4 S1 BT.
2' creek bears South 59.0', crs. N85°E from N80°W.
2' creek bears East 130.0', crs. North from S38°W.
