

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 14 and 23, T3N, R7W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing) from which a:

9" Hemlock bears N67°E 21 lks.; now a badly rotted root crown.
20" Hemlock bears S41°W 10 lks.; now a badly rotted stump with
axe marks.
Spring branch bears East 8 chains; in place.
Found 1½" x 36" iron pipe in place, set by unknown.

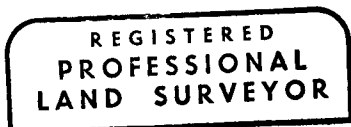
Set 1½" x 36" aluminum pipe with 3-3/4" aluminum cap marked
"STATE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY T3NR7W1/4S14S231983RS1662",
35 inches in ground, with magnet, in place of 1½" x 36" iron pipe,
which was laid alongside, and from which a:

19" Hemlock bears S64°E 13.8 ft to face; scribed 1/4S23BT.
13" Hemlock bears N16°E 18.9 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S14BT.
Original blaze bears East 29.0' on a 20" broken off Hemlock.
Original blaze bears West 138.0' on a 20" Hemlock stub.
Cat road bears East 118.0'; Crs. S30°E by N30°W.

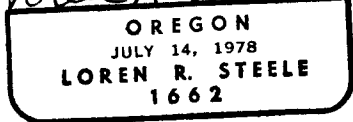
Set 4" x 4" x 84" white painted Cedar post SW 1.0 ft. from corner
