

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Line tree common to Sections 16 and 21, T3N, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, October 22, 1891.

48" cedar bears N89°45'E 20.32 chains from the section corner common to 16, 17, 20 and 21; now a 72" stump, in place, with one backcast notch on East and two notches on West side.

RESTORED

Var 21½°E

Set 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with yellow plastic cap marked "LS 1998" 34 inches into center of stump, and from which a:

17" Hemlock bears N19½°E 22.2 ft. to face; scribed APS16BT.

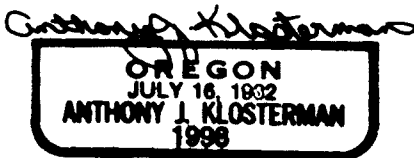
13" Fir bears S58°E 10.5 ft. to face; scribed APS21BT.

Note: Uphill side of stump was notched to allow pipe to be placed in center, as stump is about 8 ft. high and hollow.

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 6.9 ft. S78°E of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on BT's. Also poster on line tree.
