

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

West One-Sixteenth corner common to Sections 12, and 13, T3N, R10W,
W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Richard A. Morris LS401, February 20, 1963 (See Plat#
B-473, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 28" in ground;
in place, and from which a:

16" Spruce bears S28W 13.0 ft.; now a 14"x6 ft. high badly
rotted stump with portions of scribes W1/16S13BTR visible.

14" Hemlock bears N79 1/2W 52.1 ft.; missing, point falls in
cleared field.

4"x4"x60" whited painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NE; in place.
Fence bears South 0.5 ft.; missing.

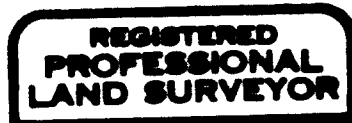
1" iron pipe set by W. Markham RE1842, September, 1953 (See
Plat# A-567 Tillamook County Records). bears S79 3/4W
3.1 ft.; now a badly rusted pipe 1 1/4" inside diameter,
15" above ground, in place.

REWITNESSED February 16, 1988 Var. 21 1/2 E
From the above pipe with marks "LS1998 1988" added, and from
which a:

15" Hemlock bears S62W 24.3 ft. to face; scribed W1/16S13BT.
8" Fir bears N84E 48.6 ft.; to face; scribed W1/16S12BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
