

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 7 and 18, T3S, R7W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Frank H. Sharp, June 28, 1894.

Post; missing.

12" Fir bears N50E 8 lks.; now a 19"x12' high stub with
portions of scribes 1/4 S visible on exposed and rotted
face, lower portion of face is not exposed. Now bears
N89E.

14" Fir bears S26W 43 lks.; now a 36"x8' high stump, partially
closed face rotted out, axe work visible in bark.

RESTORATION by Lynn M. Rosenberry, B.L.M. Cadastral Engineer, 1959
Group 350.

2 1/2"x28" iron post with brass cap, 24" in ground; in place.

30" Fir bears N35E 6 lks.; now a 30"x8' stump with scribes
1/4 S7 BT visible.

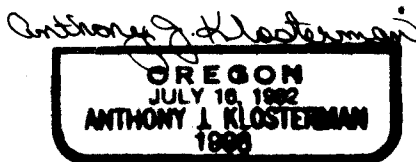
From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1988" added, and from which

12" Fir bears N08 1/2W 32.4 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S7BT.
13" Fir bears S58E 31.5 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S18BT.

1959 B.L.M. metal location poster on 30" Fir stump bears N35E 6 lks.
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
