

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

West one quarter corner for Section 7, T1N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by John A. Hurlburt, September 13, 1874.

Hemlock post; missing.

36" Hemlock bears S52E 35 lks.; now rotted remains of root crown.  
30" Hemlock bears S80W 21 lks.; now rotted remains of root crown.

RESTORED by Lyle E. Byers LS199, May 30, 1951. (Book 2, page 105, Tillamook Co. Records.)

1 1/2"x36" Galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground; in place.

12" Hemlock bears S28E 24.3 ft.; now a 16"x 6 ft. high badly burnt stub with scribes 1/4 S7 199 BT visible.

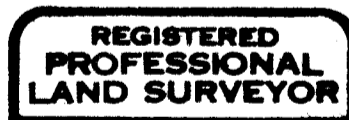

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1988" added a:

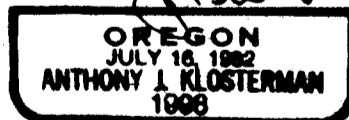
13" Fir bears S13E 7.5 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S7BT.
