

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Line tree common to Sections 3 and 4, T1S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Frank H. Sharp, September 6, 1893.

60" Fir with 2 notches on North and South sides bears S00-03E 20.27 chains from the Closing corner for Sections 3 and 4; now a 67" stump with 2 notches on South side.

NOTE: O.S.D.F. stadia notes dated August, 1955 state, "tack in original line tree"; found in place.

Var. 21 1/2 E

Set 5/8"x36" Steel rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "LS1998", 34" into center of stump, and from which a:

16" Fir bears N16W 10.9 ft. to face; scribed WPS4BT.

10" Fir bears N64E 7.9 ft. to face; scribed WPS3BT.

Centerline Coast Range Road bears South 108.7 ft.

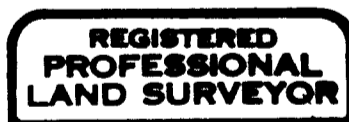
Metal location poster on BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of BTs.

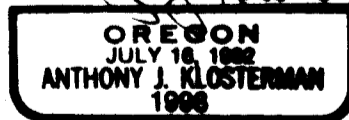
Also poster on 17" Fir bears South 120.7 ft. on South edge of Coast Range Road.
