One quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 11, T2S, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Albert F. Wilson, July 20, 1891.

Post; missing.

32" Hemlock bears N28E 18 lks.; now uprooted, rotted and badly shattered stub with scribes 1/4 S visible on burnt face.
29" Hemlock bears S10W 57 lks.; missing.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, December 31, 1951 (Book 2, page 100, Tillamook Co. Records.)

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground, in mound of stone; in place.

40" Fir stump bears S79E 23.1 ft.; now 31" x 6 ft. high, badly rotted with no scribes visible.
48" Fir stump bears N73W 65.7 ft.; now 4 ft. high, rotted with scribes 1/4 S2 BT 2311 visible.

REWITNESSED November 26, 1990

Var. 21 1/2 E

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1990" added, a:

12" Fir bears N03 1/2E 12.5 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S2BT.
11" Fir bears S70W 33.1 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S11BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
