I found a 1 1/2" X 8" iron bar with a broken 3" Tillamook County Surveyors Brass Cap (see T.C.S. Rewitness Bin #353), approximately 3" deep in the East bound lane of Long Prairie County Road. I set a 5/8" X 12" iron rod with a 3" Tillamook County Surveyors Brass Cap in an 8" cast iron monument case and encased in concrete at the position of the found monument.

History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described in said T.C.S. Rewitness and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

Guy Pole #P29L46GS N.41°30'E. 52.70'; (Now gone)

Power Pole #P29L46 N.35°30'W. 36.00'; (Found, O.K. New pole number is #048503).

Hub tack in Southeast garage foundation N.21°W. 68.26'; (Found corner, did not find tack).

*96" hat section post N.48°E. 50.6'; (Found, O.K.).

New Accessory

Power Pole #048403 S.11°W. 120.49'. The distance was measured to a hub tack in a scribed triangle in the side center of the pole.

Punch mark in a chiseled triangle on top of a fire hydrant N.59°E. 46.94'. Top of triangle points North and a * is chiseled below the top of hydrant for alignment, in case the top is turned.

*indicates Tillamook County Surveyors yellow metal location poster attached.

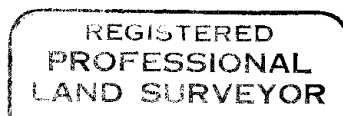
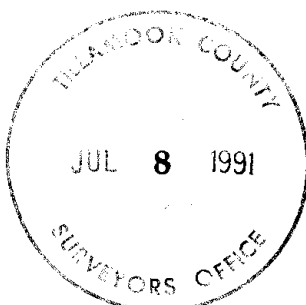
Location of Monument
