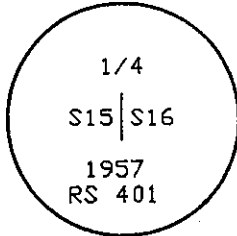

I FOUND A 1 1/2' IRON PIPE WITH A 3' D. S. B. F. BRONZE CAP, (SEE T.C.S. REWITNESS BOOK 1 AT PAGE 310). I ENCASED THE FOUND IRON PIPE IN A IRREGULAR MASS OF CONCRETE.

**HISTORY OF FOUND MONUMENT**

I FOUND THIS MONUMENT TO BE AS DESCRIBED IN TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS REWITNESS BOOK 1 AT PAGE 310 AND THE REFERENCES FOUND AND/OR SET AT THAT TIME TO NOW BE AS FOLLOWS:

(ORIGINAL G.L.D.) 10' HEMLOCK N.41°W. 14LKS., REPORTED ON THE ABOVE REWITNESS AS A 24' STUB 4' HIGH FACE AND SCRIBES ROTTED OFF; (FOUND, NOW VERY ROTTEN 20' STUMP, 2' HIGH).

(ORIGINAL G.L.D.) 8' HEMLOCK N.64°E. 23LKS., REPORTED ON THE ABOVE REWITNESS AS A 16' STUB 4' HIGH FACE AND SCRIBE 'S' VISIBLE ON PARTIALLY EXPOSED FACE; (FOUND, NOW FALLEN AND VERY ROTTEN).

(BOOK 1 PAGE 310) 11' FIR N.56 1/2°W. 64.8 FT.; (FOUND, NOW A 30' FIR AT POSITION, WITH A YELLOW METAL LOCATION POSTER ATTACHED. LOCATED AT THE TOP EDGE OF A VERTICAL SLOPE, ORIGINALLY A CUT FOR AN OLD ROAD).

(BOOK 1 PAGE 310) 7' SPRUCE N.43°E. 51.3 FT.; (FOUND, NOW A 17' SPRUCE AT POSITION, FACE HEALED, YELLOW METAL LOCATION POSTER ATTACHED).

(BOOK 1 PAGE 310) 4' SPRUCE S.50°W. 2.3 FT.; (FOUND, NOW A 24' SPRUCE AT POSITION, YELLOW METAL LOCATION POSTER ATTACHED).

4'X 4'X 60' W.C.P. 1.0' SE OF PIPE; (FOUND, LOOSE IN ROOTS OF SPRUCE).

72' LIGHT HAT SECTION POST NORTH 1.5'.\*

SET 5/8' IRON ROD WITH RED PLASTIC CAP, IN ROOT OF 30' FIR, N.89°10'25"E. 230.59'. TREE STEM BEARS N.20°E. 0.5'.

SET 5/8' IRON ROD WITH RED PLASTIC CAP, IN ROOT OF 21' HEMLOCK, N.66°41'34"W. 74.94'. TREE STEM BEARS N.50°W. 0.4'.

BASIS OF BEAINGS IS TRUE FROM A TIE TO RANDOM POINTS FOUND FROM MAP A-6177.
