One quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, T1N, R10W,  
W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Samuel D. Snowden, May 13, 1857.

Post; missing.

24" Spruce bears South 35 lks.; missing.  
24" Spruce bears N50°W 17 lks.; missing.  
Top of Ridge bears N89°55'E 2.22 chains; in place.

REESTABLISHED by Richard A. Morris LS401, December 31, 1959 (Book  
2, page 440 Tillamook County Records).

At a point on line 2.22 chains N89°53'58" W from above ridge  
set a 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 30 inches in the ground  
in mound of rock; now 36" in ground, in place.

10" Fir bears N60°E 90.7 ft.; now a 24" windfall laying  
on face.  
7" Fir bears S11°E 79.6 ft.; now 28" with face closed.  
4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. SE of pipe;  
missing.

18" Fir bears N58½°E 16.9 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S25BT

1/4S36BT.  
10" Fir bears N49½°W 43.0 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S25BT

Metal location poster on new BTs.  
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.  
6 ft. Orange carsonite post bears S64°W 2.25 ft.
