14"x9"x5" basalt stone 10" in ground with $\frac{1}{2}$ on West face;
missing.

12" Hemlock bears S47°E 8 lks.; missing.

6" Hemlock bears N42°W 12 lks.; missing.

Foot of 75 ft. high stone cliff, course East by West,
bears South 5.00 chains; in place. From foot of
cliff a waterfall 75 ft. high 80 lks. East of line;
in place.

S30 2000 LS2272", 24" in ground, in 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ 'x4'x1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' mound of
stone, from which a:

17" Maple bears N58°E 7.5 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S30BT.

14" Alder bears S36°E 71.8 ft. to barkscribes 1/4S30BT.

15" Alder bears S73 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W 31.8 ft. to barkscribes 1/4S25BT.

15" Hemlock bears N24°W 54.9 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S25BT.

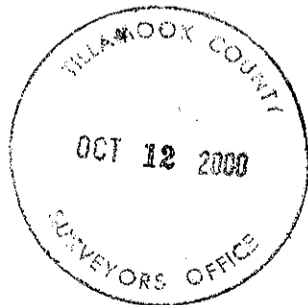
Metal location poster on BTs.
