I Found:

Original GLO stone 18"x12"x7" in stone mound in old cat road, approximately 200' North of South end of road, on small flat.

From which:

 $4\text{"x}\ 4\text{"}$  white painted cedar post bears 1.5' Southeast. (See Rewitness Book 1, Page 300)

42" Fir snag with tag & scribing bears S85°E 65.2'. (42" Fir stub bears S85°E 65.2 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S26 BT RS359. Rewitness Book 1, Page 300)

60" Fir stump with scribing bears N83°W 13.1'. (60" Fir stump bears N83°W 13.1 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S22 BT. Rewitness Book 1, Page 300)

40'' Fir stump with scribing bears N5°E 84.8'. (40" Fir stump bears N5°E 84.8 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S23 BT. Rewitness Book 1, Page 300)

SW BT gone. (24" x 5 ft. Fir stub bears S29°W 31.3 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S27 BT. Rewitness Book 1, Page 300)

No evidence of original GLO BTs

I drove a brass nail & 14" brass washer stamped "LS 2507 S22 S23 S27 S26 2002" in the top of the stone and placed a magnet along the west side of stone.

From which:

Set an Orange carsonite post 4' North, and 4 New BTs as follows:

10" Alder bark scribed "T2S R8W S22 BT" bears N35°W 22.95' to brass nail & washer stamped "LS 2507" between the B & T;

10" Spruce scribed "S23 BT" bears N39°E 38.15' to brass nail & washer stamped "LS 2507" between the B & T;

16" Douglas Fir scribed "S27 BT" bears S33°E 22.80' to brass nail & washer stamped "LS 2507" between the B & T;

17" Douglas Fir scribed "S26 BT" bears S66°E 54.80' to brass nail & washer stamped "LS 2507" between the B & T;

Twin 16" Alder stumps ±2'Northwest.
