

<b>Monument Set(Procedures &amp; Description):</b> The lid to the 8" diameter monument case was removed and the case was filled with concrete. The contractor was given permission to fill the monument case with asphalt by the Tillamook County Surveyor. A 2" diameter Tillamook County Brass Disk was placed at road surface.
