

Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3-1/4" Bureau of Land Management brass cap approximately 1.0' above the ground in a rock mound. The found monument is upright and in good condition. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Placed a 12" diameter plastic cylinder filled with 120 pounds of concrete around the monument. Found an iron fence post 2.0' West of found corner monument. (BLM Field Notes Volume: OR-R0118 Page 0748.00) – Found a weathered stone with no marks remaining lying along side a rock mound at the found monument. The stone was described as being 14" X 13" X 10" when it was set by surveyor Henry Meldrum in 1873. (OR-R0567 Pages 0127.00 to 0131.00) – Found a 43" diameter Fir tree with a healed face at record position. The tree has no visible scribe marks but does have a 1957 yellow BLM metal location tag nailed to the tree, (record position and description of the bearing tree from BLM Field Note Volume OR-R0567 Pages 0130.00 = a 35" diameter Fir bearing S.64 1/2° W 45 lks = 29.70' marked "1/4 S27 BT"). (OR-R0567 Pages 0127.00 to 0131.00) – Found a 13" diameter Maple tree bearing N 10° E at distance of 37.4'. The tree has no visible markings, (record position and description of the bearing tree from BLM Field Note Volume OR-R0567 Pages 0130.00 = a 11" diameter Maple tree bearing N 9° E 57 lks = 37.62' marked "1/4 S26 BT"). () Indicates record information from BLM

New accessories set: Set a 72" hat section post 3.0' South of monument.		
New Bearing Trees set: A 67" diameter multi-top Maple tree which bears North 15° East 32.7' scribed "T3SR7W1/4S26BT", tagged and painted.		
Location & Comments: The corner is located approximately 250' South of Upper Nestucca River Road and approximately 60' West of a bend in the creek.
