Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): In 1976, a Rewitness was performed by Tillamook County Surveyor's Office, where they found some remaining GLO accessories and a 3/4" Iron Pipe with new Bearing Trees apparently set by CZ Corporation with no recorded evidence. They then set a new monument at the position of the found pipe.			
<p>Now: Found 3" dia. Tillamook County Brass Cap, flush, in concrete, good condition. Found a 4" X 4" white cedar post (West 1.5'), hat section post (South 1.5'), 2" Iron Pipe leaning East (East 0.75'). Tied the monument using GPS directly.
