To: Whom It May Concern

My name is Nicholas Torres, and I am the Tillamook County, OR Veterans Service Officer. Tillamook County is comprised of about twenty-five hundred Veterans. We are located over forty miles from the nearest VA Medical Center and many of our Veterans participate in the VA's Community Care program.

One of the main functions of Tillamook County Veterans Services is to advocate for Veteran's Suicide Awareness and Prevention. Historically, Tillamook County has experienced multiple Veteran suicides per year. Everyone one can agree that is too many.
