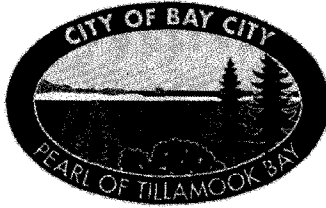

Dear Commissioners:

We are aware that the Commissioners are currently soliciting comments on a proposed modification to Title III Grant Agreement #5010. Please accept this letter as our comments.

This modification will result in the availability of funding for the continuation of the so-called Yard Debris Voucher program through September 30, 2021. Without these additional funds, the program is at risk of being terminated mid-year.

This program has supported residents in creating and maintaining “defensible spaces” around their homes, which is an important part of creating Fire Wise communities.

This program provides residents a viable opportunity to dispose of debris, rather than burning it. Our Fire Department considers this program one of the best tools in the toolbox to deter residents from burning. As we enter into fire restrictions earlier than usual this year, it is especially important that this program continue through September 30th.

As the city closest to the Pike Road Fire in 2020, Bay City may understand better than some other communities the importance of this program. That is why the City Council has committed to reimburse the Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) for up to \$2,000 of yard debris disposal expenses incurred by ODF in the event that the County Commissioners do not approve this modification. But we hope that this will not be necessary, and that the County Commissioners will approve this modification and allocation of funds for this program to continue.
