# 2021 Statistics

- ▶ 427 Survivors with 11046 services
  - ▶ 364 adults and 63 teens/children
  - ▶ 27% of survivors were Latinx
- ▶ 42 Protection Orders were filed
- ▶ 524 Crisis/Helpline Calls Answered
- ▶ 58 AIR Calls
- ▶ 683 Bednights (51 adults and children sheltered & safehoused)
