CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION JUSTICE REINVESTMENT GRANT PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT #JR 23-026 AMENDMENT NO. 1

This is Amendment Number 1 to Grant Agreement No. JR 23-026 ("Agreement") between the State of Oregon, acting by and through the Criminal Justice Commission ("CJC"), and Tillamook County ("Grantee").
