








City Council Goals for Carnahan Park



Carnahan Boat Dock Replacement



Dock was aging significantly with rotten spots, missing tie cleats, and having reports of visitors stepping though the dock.

The city thought of removing the dock entirely but due to many visitors fishing and this being a popular boat ramp the city decided against it

- County approves request to use remaining funds with Amendment 1 to TLT Agreement
- City spends total of \$72,712 of TLT funds on project.....still under budget!


