FORMAL RULES OF PROBATION

- You shall report as directed, either in person, or by phone to the Juvenile Department (201 Laurel Avenue, Tillamook, OR 503-842-3417)
- You shall obey all laws (including curfew laws), which means - do not commit another offense. Obey all orders of the Court.
- You shall obey all rules of the home or any other placement. Do not run away.
- You shall follow all lawful directives of your Juvenile Counselor.
- You shall promptly, truthfully, and completely answer all inquiries made by Juvenile Department staff.
- You shall not be absent from your home/residence for more than 24 consecutive hours unless accompanied by an adult who is approved by your parent/guardian/custodian. You must seek pre-approval from the Juvenile Department for any period of absence that will be longer than 7 days.
- You shall not leave the State of Oregon without the permission of the Juvenile Department.
- You shall enroll in and attend an approved education program: on all scheduled days with no unexcused absences.
- You shall be home by _____ on weeknights and by _____ on Friday or Saturday nights unless accompanied by a parent/guardian/custodian, or unless otherwise approved by the Juvenile Department.
- You shall not knowingly associate with any person who is under the jurisdiction of any Court, except where approved by the Juvenile Department. Do not knowingly associate with anyone who is violating the law.
- You shall not use or possess alcoholic beverages, intoxicants, illegal/ dangerous drugs, controlled substances, or prescription drugs unless prescribed to you by your medical provider.

- You shall notify your Juvenile Counselor within 24 hours of any change in residence, school, employment. You shall provide your Juvenile Counselor with all new contact information (phone, address, etc.) at the time of notification.
- You shall notify your Juvenile Counselor within 24 hours of any formal contact with law enforcement.
- You shall not use or possess weapons, firearms or dangerous animals.
- You shall participate in any detection, diagnostic, or therapeutic procedure and/or program as determined by the Court and/or your Juvenile Counselor.
- You shall participate in and cooperate with any assessment/ diagnostic, counseling or treatment as directed by the Court, your Juvenile Counselor, your parent/guardian/custodian, your placement, or your school.
- If ordered by the Court, you shall pay, through the Circuit Court, any and all restitution according to terms fixed by the Court. Failure to comply may result in further Court action.
- You shall complete community service hours as ordered by the Court. You have a total of _____ hours of community service to complete and they need to be completed by _____, **20**_____.
- You may be fingerprinted and photographed as directed by the Juvenile Department under O.R.S 419A.250 submit to blood or buccal swab pursuant to O.R.S 137.076.
- You shall comply with any additional conditions of probation specifically imposed by the Court (*see Court Order and/or additional Rules documents*).

You shall:

- Seek, obtain, maintain employment.
- Obtain a General Equivalency Diploma (GED).
- Follow and cooperate with all drug and alcohol conditions (*see Court Order*).
- Follow and cooperate with all _____ Special Conditions of Probation (*see additional Rules document*).

Submit to Random and/or Reasonable Suspicion urinalysis, or alternative substance use testing method, by any Juvenile Department staff member, medical professional, or designee.

Submit to Random and/or Reasonable Suspicion search and seizure of your person, residence, vehicle or property by any Juvenile Department staff member, law enforcement officer, or designee without a search warrant.

These Rules are in addition to any requirements specified on your Court Order.

I have received a copy of the Formal Rules of Probation, which have been read and explained to me. I understand that they apply to me and I agree to comply with them. If I comply, my probation will terminate successfully. If I do not comply, I may be returned to Court, and the Court may find that I have violated probation. If the Court finds that I have violated probation, the Court may order that I be detained or, if my referral warrants, commit me to the custody of the Oregon Youth Authority. I also understand that a Civil Judgement may be entered against me for the amount of any monies I have been ordered to pay that are unpaid on my 18th birthday.
