This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on April 23, 2025 at the request of Linda Hanratty, President of the Tillamook County Wide Prayer Team. The Board, being fully apprised, finds as follows:

1. The National Day of Prayer is a tradition first proclaimed by the Continental Congress in 1775.
2. The National Day of Prayer was established as an annual event by a joint resolution of Congress in 1952 and signed into law by President Truman. The law was amended in 1988 and signed by President Reagan designating it as the first Thursday in May each year.
3. The Board of County Commissioners is grateful for the ecumenical work of the Tillamook Countywide Prayer Team in bringing Tillamook County citizens together to pray for our county and its citizens, the state, and the nation on this National Day of Prayer.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that:

4. The Tillamook County Board of Commissioners hereby proclaims Thursday, May 1, 2025 as a "*Day of Prayer*" in Tillamook County and invites citizens to observe this day in ways appropriate and significant to their personal practices of faith.




